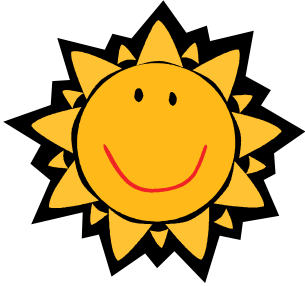

Recital Rehearsal Schedule

June 22 – Monday - at **CPAM Recital #1** afternoon recital rehearsal and Awards Ceremony -**dance class attire**- begins promptly at 5:30pm- please come 15 min early. Sit in large dance studio on the floor for awards. Dances will run in the order of the show, when you have completed all of your dances you are set to leave. Students and parents will wait in the small dance room. Students only will be called into the large dance room when it is time for them to dance-parents will wait in the waiting room. We run these rehearsals as quickly and as smoothly as possible so that the students will be familiar with the order of the recital and the amount of time between each of their dances.

June 23 – Tuesday - at **CPAM Recital #2** evening recital rehearsal and Awards Ceremony -**dance class attire**- begins promptly at 5:30pm

June 25 – Thursday – 4pm **DRESS REHEARSAL COSTUMES** COSTUMES, TIGHTS, SHOES, HAIR AND MAKE-UP ALL CORRECT- at Timberlane Performing Arts Center, 40 Greenough Road, Plaistow, NH
NO EATING OR DRINKING IN THE THEATER-
ONLY ONE ADULT ALLOWED FOR EACH FAMILY OF DANCERS-
NO SIBLINGS OR FAMILY MEMBERS are allowed at rehearsal-
PICTURES ARE ALLOWED AT REHEARSAL-
PICTURES ARE **NOT ALLOWED AT RECITAL**
YOUNG CHILDREN MAY CHANGE IN THE AUDITORIUM-older dancers may change in dressing rooms. Your student may leave after they have completed all of their dances.

Dances at rehearsal will not run in order of the show, they will run in sets of classes beginning at **4:30 (see attached schedule) and ending at 9pm**. All students wait in the auditorium quietly SEATED while watching AND will be called up onto stage to rehearse.

RECITAL SUNDAY JUNE 28TH-CALL TIME FOR PERFORMERS IS **1 hour before** show time- AUDITORIUM DOORS WILL OPEN AND SLIDE SHOW WILL BEGIN 30minutes before show time. Audience members are only allowed in and out of auditorium during black outs not during dance / voice routines.
