Understand the Tuition Policies

Early, Regular and Late Tuition-Payment Methods

Pay by cash, check or debit and credit!

Early Tuition 10% discount- only accepted before the last day of the month for the next month - pays for a costume over the course of the year.

You may pay early tuition as many months in advance as you would like. There are no refunds or credits for early tuition. Early tuition is only accepted before the 30th of the month before the month you are paying for. The check must be received on time to qualify. Example if your child has the check in their bag for a week and forgets to pass it in and it is now the 5th of the month EARLY tuition would no longer apply.

Regular Tuition is due between the 1st and 15th of the month that you are paying for.

Late tuition is any tuition not paid for by the 15th of the current month. 10% of the tuition is applied to the regular tuition and an invoice is given to the family and the student is not able to attend the following month of classes unless tuition is up to date.

WE NOW ACCEPT BANK DEBIT CARDS, VISA, MASTERCARD, DISCOVER AND AMERICAN EXPRESS! You may now purchase with the convenience of credit and debit cards at CPAM for class tuition, dance shoes and clothes, costume, recital tickets, and Arbonne health and beauty supplies.

Dance Class Dress Code:

Hair pulled securely off face.

In all CPAM's dance classes pink/black clothing is expected to be worn by girls and black/white for boys. You can conveniently purchase pink and black leotards, tights, dance skirts, shorts, capris and cargo pants here at CPAM.

In the cool weather black and pink dance (tight fitting) sweaters and legwarmers are recommended.

CPAM logo clothing is also allowed over leotards and tights and is appropriate for hip-hop and drama/Voice Class and all fun events like the Methuen Santa Parade. Fill in an order form, if you need assistance with sizing simply ask Michelle or her assistant to help you.
